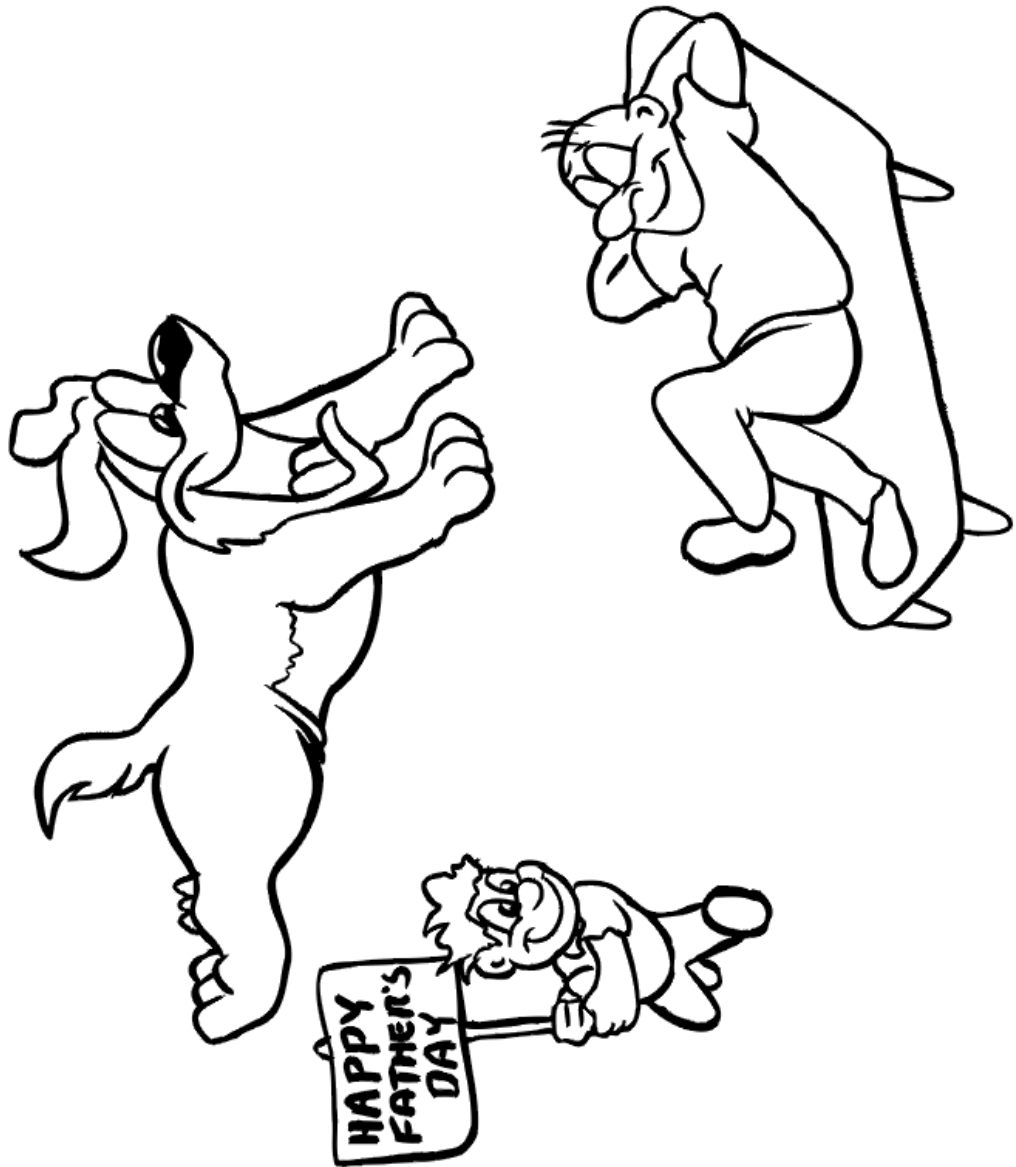

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY—COLOURING IN



FATHER'S DAY CRAFTS— DAD ROCKS PAPERWEIGHT (Kaboose.com)

CRAFT MATERIALS:

- 1 rock heavy enough to weight down paper, about a palm size
- Acrylic paint (We chose blue)
- Gold glitter glue
- Paintbrush
- Acrylic sealer spray
- Black marker

How to Make it:

1. Choose a rock that is about the size of your palm. It should be heavy enough to weight down a few papers and not be blown away.
2. Wash the rock with warm, soapy water and a scrub brush; be sure to get into all the crevices. Wipe off water with a towel.
3. After rock has completely dried, paint the entire rock with acrylic paint. Let the paint dry and then paint on a second coat.
4. Paint the entire rock with a thin layer of glitter glue and then let dry.
5. Use a squeezable glitter glue bottle to carefully write "DAD ROCKS" on the rock. Let dry overnight.

6. The next day, use a black marker to outline the letters to make them stand out better.
7. Get a grown-up to spray the entire surface of rock with acrylic sealer spray.

Tips:

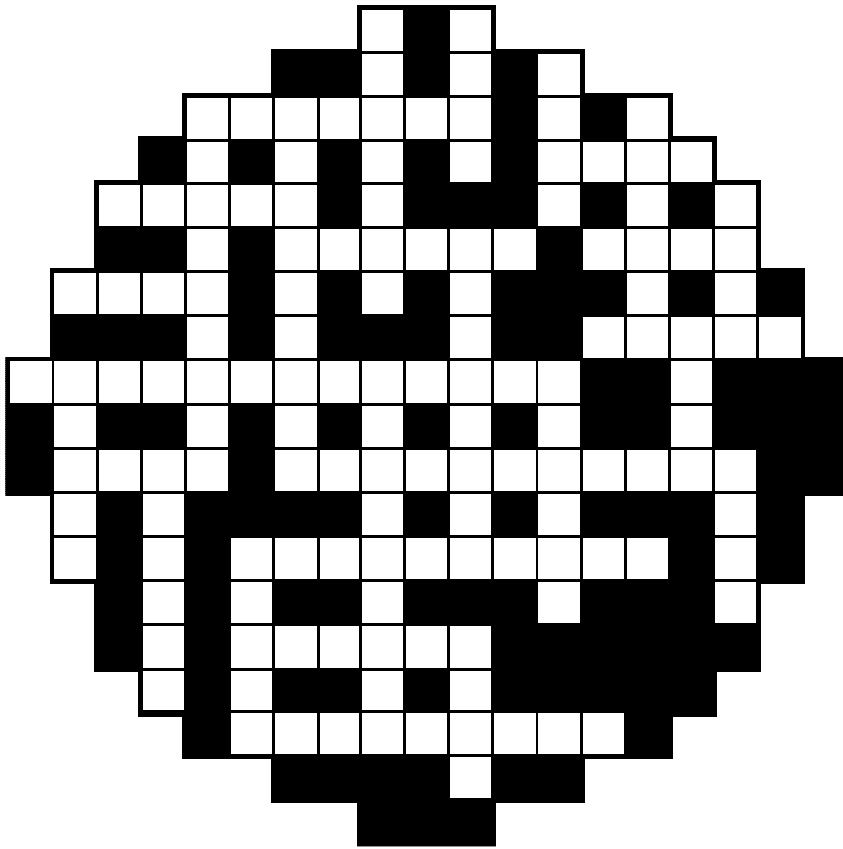
- Instead of writing the words with glitter glue, try a paint pen. They write like a pen but go on like paint. You can find them at your local craft supply store.
- Some glitter glues dry puffy and some dry flat (like ours). Experiment with yours first if you like to see how it will turn out.
- Instead of just one rock, paint two and put "DAD" on one and "ROCKS" on the other for a matching set.

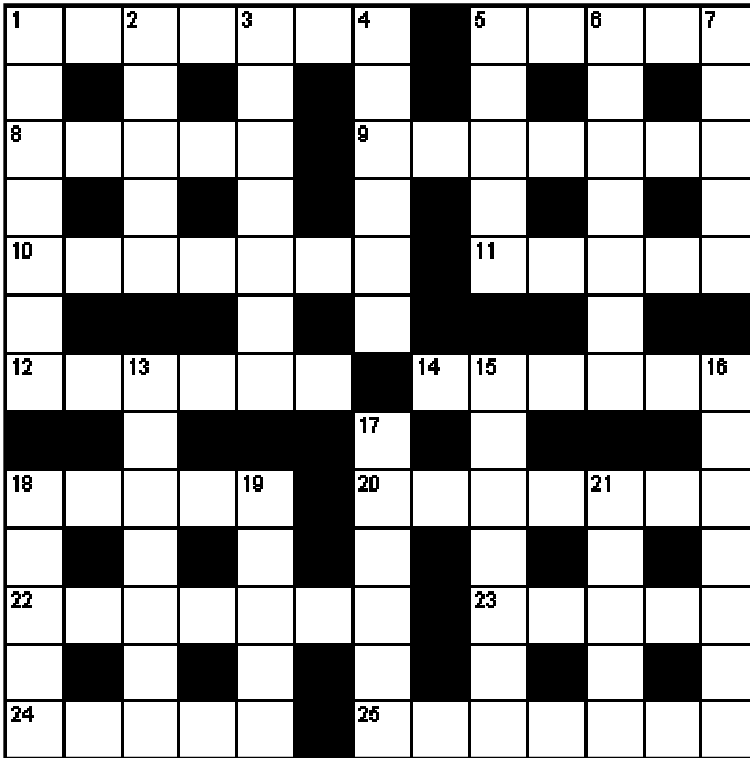

Tips for Authors:

The following points outline what I am looking for in stories:

2. Each story should be at least 1 page long where possible, longer is fine.
3. Try to include details about your pet's life before adoption (i.e. was a racer, blood donor, etc.) and what their life was like after adoption. Be sure to include as many details about their personality and cute or anecdotal stories about them.
4. Please make sure submissions are in Word document format.
5. In your email, make sure to tell me which adoption or rescue organization you are affiliated with.

More on What bones to give your pooch!!

Many greyhound owners feed their dogs chicken necks, chicken wings and chicken carcasses. These bones are perfectly safe to feed your dog as long as they are RAW. Dogs have special enzymes in their digestive tracts which digest raw bones.

It is COOKED bones which can cause Problems, as the enzymes do not work with cooked bones.

Also, I don't agree with feeding dogs marrow bones. These bones are extremely hard as they are weight-bearing bones of large animals - the hardness of these bones has been known to break dog's teeth. There are many dog owners that don't agree with feeding dogs large marrow bones for this reason.

After the dog has licked the marrow, he/she is then left with this very hard bone to chew on.

Remember —If in doubt—speak to your own trusted vet.
